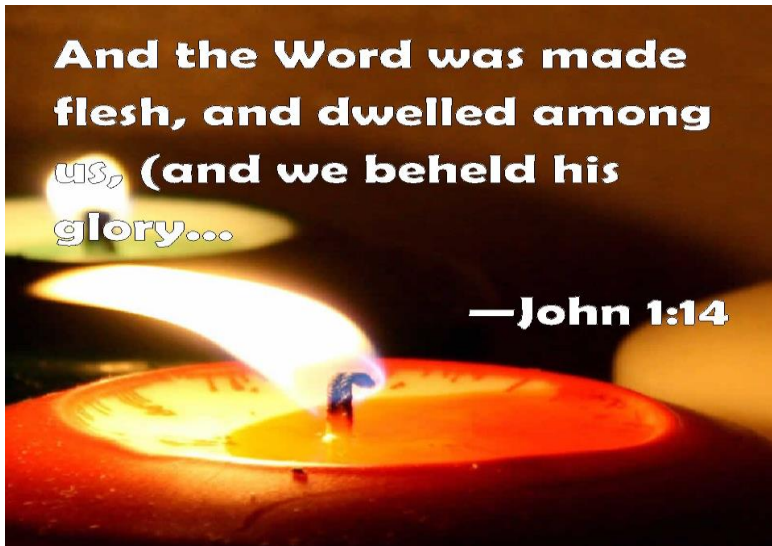

**Lingfield Pipe Organ** – Our organ restorer has completed a substantial part of the work on our church organ, and it is hoped that we will have the instrument fully back in operation very soon. A number of old faults were found which had to be repaired resulting in the long delay to completion. The stop jamb on the left-hand side of the console has been modified in their workshop to include additional functions. The hired organ has been returned to Viscount Organs.
