

**Distribution of the Host during Eucharist** – To answer some questions, reference should be made to the current the Church of England instructions dated January 12, 2021, see link: - [COVID-19 Advice on the Administration of Holy Communion v5.3.pdf \(churchofengland.org\)](#). The last sentence of part 5 reads: - *'At the distribution, Holy Communion is administered in silence. The consecrated bread or wafer will need to be dropped into the hands of communicants.'* Hence the Celebrant is not permitted to state 'The Body of Christ' until a new instruction is issued.

**Church open times during the day** – The church will be open each day of the week from about 9.30am to 4.30pm. On Sundays it will be open in time for the 8.00am service and closed after the 4.00pm service, if applicable. The wearing of face masks and social distancing should be continued until the national recommendations decide otherwise.

**United Benefice Sunday** services will continue at 4.00pm. In compliance with current Covid regulations places at **St John's** will be restricted so must be booked. Face masks must be worn in both churches, and social distancing maintained.

**East Grinstead Summer Bags Appeal, 220 needed by July 12** – This appeal is in aid of the food bags distributed by schools to local families experiencing difficult times. EGFB are collecting many items such as: - tins of fruit, fish, ham/corned beef, biscuits, cupcakes, raisins, anti bac wipes, etc to make up these bags. The St Peter & St Paul PCC has offered to provide 50 mini packs of 10 peperamis,, which was one of the items listed. 
