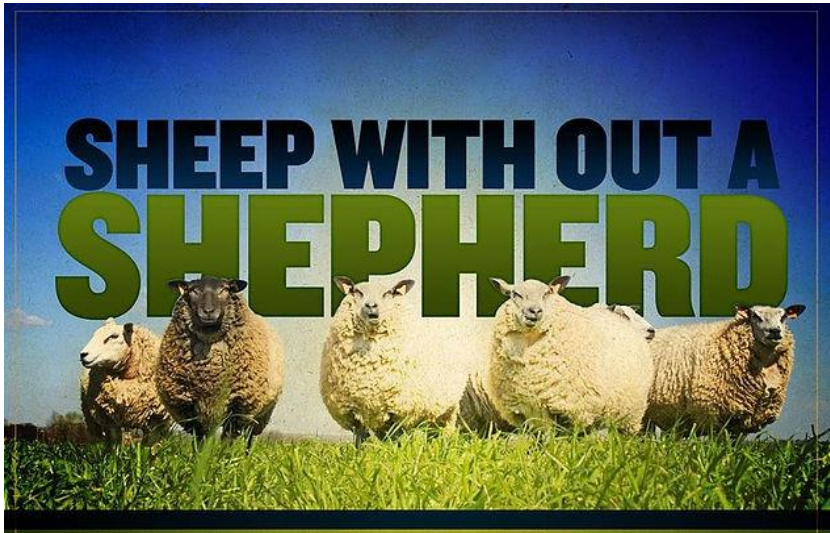

Distribution of the Host during Eucharist – To answer some questions, reference should be made to the current the Church of England instructions dated January 12, 2021, see link: - [COVID-19 Advice on the Administration of Holy Communion v5.3.pdf \(churchofengland.org\)](#). The last sentence of part 4 reads: -

'At the distribution, Holy Communion is administered in silence. The consecrated bread or wafer will need to be dropped into the hands of communicants.'

Hence the Celebrant is not permitted to state 'The Body of Christ' until a new instruction is issued.

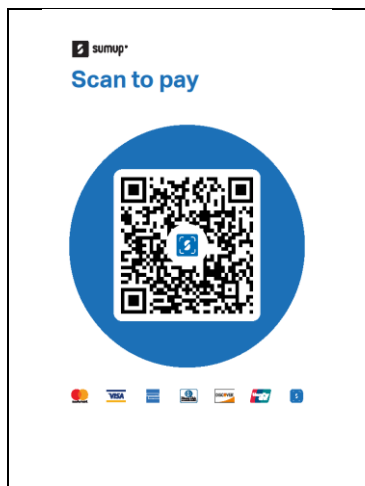
