Thursday March 2 - **Syria and Turkey earthquake disaster fund meal**. It is difficult not to be affected by the appalling situation, the death toll is already over 25,000, but will probably increase. We all wish we could help but feel impotent. This is a great community, so let's try and do something practical.

The owner of the **Chef's Cuisine in Lingfield High Street** has generously agreed to provide a Turkish meal for £30, of which £20 will contribute to their costs and £10 will be donated to the Disaster Emergency Committee. The meal will be at 7.00pm, with traditional Turkish entertainment. There is limited space for 50 people, which means that with government support we can raise about £1,000. This will provide 20 families with temporary accommodation and blankets, and food for 10 days.
