Stewardship Financial Giving - You will all have received a letter from me, seen or heard about the appeal to prayerfully consider your financial giving towards the running, upkeep and Mission of St Peter and St Paul. I have suggested using the Parish Giving Scheme, details are as follows.

The process is: -

- Go on-line to www.parishgiving.org.uk,
- Search for St Peter & St Paul Lingfield, use our PGS code of **370637125**,
- Enter the requested details,
- Tell Mike Ellis, our Treasurer, of your decision to move to PGS,
- Please don't cancel your current standing order until the PGS becomes active.

PGS provides the automatic monthly transfer of all St Peter & St Paul contributions to our bank account, and the return a few days later of the HMRC repayment of the gift aid applicable to your payment.

If you still wish to continue using your current giving process, please complete a gift aid form, which means we can recover from HMRC **25p over and above from every £** you contribute. It is a very simple and easy system. Thank you all. Ian.
