Please book by emailing SusanJoy471@hotmail.com RWC offers welcome and support to refugees from Syria, Afghanistan and Ukraine all of whom have arrived on government schemes since 2016 as well those from troubled and war-torn places such as Iran, Sudan, the Congo, Yemen and Eritrea. Many of these refugees have spent many months in hotels waiting for their cases to be resolved. RWC provides informal English lessons to help integration into our local community, friendship and advice, clothes, shoes and essential household items. Pope Francis has said that the Church's mission and social justice teaching has no limits in showing love and being at the side of refugees and migrants worldwide. Sue & David provided their garden (we are most grateful) for the Church Fete, so most people will know the exact location, although your head may be still hazy from the refreshments on offer!

Possible closure of Lingfield Station ticket office – The Department of Transport (DfT) has instructed the Rail Delivery Group (RDG) to cut costs which may result in the closure of up to 1000 staffed local ticket offices, including Lingfield Station. You can submit your opinion to ticketoffice.GTR@transportfocus.org.uk before **July 26**. There is a petition to sign at the station, but emails may have more clout. Sue Sharp.
