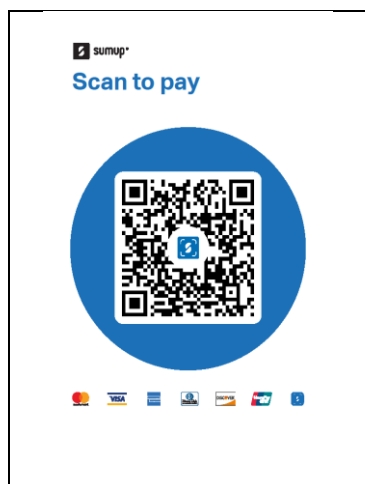
### OTHER INFORMATION
