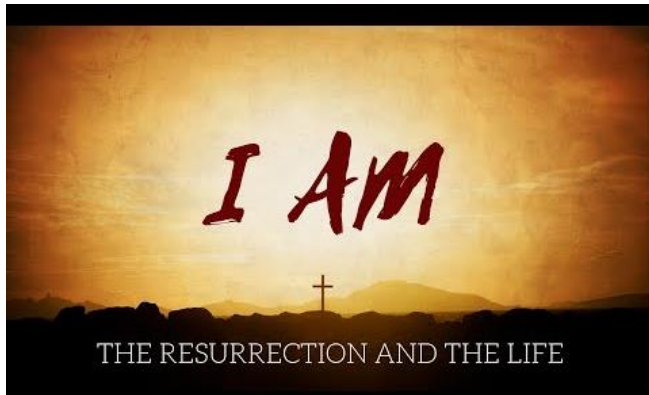

Kathryn will become part of the bishop's senior staff team, serving and enabling the ministry of parishes in the Bishop's Waltham, Gosport, Fareham and Petersfield Deaneries.

Kathryn will work alongside the bishop, the Rt Rev Jonathan Frost, and the two other archdeacons in the diocese – the Ven Jenny Rowley as Archdeacon of Portsdown, who supports parishes in Portsmouth and Havant, and the Ven Steve Daugherty, Archdeacon of the Isle of Wight.
