



Sunday March 9 – We welcome today as our celebrant **The Revd David Williams**, **Chairman of the College of St Barnabas**. Ordained in 2008, he was Clerk to the Church of England's General Synod and Head of the Archbishops' Council's Central Secretariat. Now retired he helps at St. Martin's Dorking, and St. Matthew's Redhill (as curate). He was a community mediator with the Surrey Mediation Service and a magistrate for 35 years.
