You can set up your Direct Debit online, fill in a gift form at church, or call our **PGS** team, 0333 002 1271 and we will talk you through it, step by step.

You can also make a one-off gift to your church online at any time.

At **PGS**, we make it safe and easy for you to give and just as safe and easy for your church to receive. We process gifts and Gift Aid on your church's behalf, so every pound you give can be put to Christian service in your community.

A unique feature of **PGS** is the option for givers to increase their gift annually in line with inflation. While this is a voluntary decision, it is one that could potentially have a huge impact on the life and future of your church. We'll calculate the difference each year and notify you in advance to ask if you're happy to increase your gift by the cost of living.
