A balanced Easter diet is a chocolate egg in each hand"



Neighbourhood Watch Update



Latest available reported crime between 12th February to 12th March 2026. Please remember these statistics are only as good as the information received so please

report any crimes to ensure both an accurate reflection but also greater support from Surrey Policing for our village.

Three crimes have been advised via the Tandridge Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter for Dormansland/Dormans Park area during this 4 week period.

Vehicle Crime

Hillcrest, Dormans Park – Keyless Theft. Overnight 21st to 22nd February a grey Ford Carrier index YR68KGN was stolen and gates to the driveway were driven through and damaged.

Jeddere Cottages, Dormansland – Criminal Damage. Overnight 3rd to 4th March all four tyres of a car were slashed.

Burglary Residential including Sheds and Garages Vehicle Crime

Eden Vale, Dormans Park. Between 19.15 and 20.15 28th February the doors of a garage were forced open and a step ladder was taken from within and used to gain entry to an upstairs window by smashing it before entering the property. Items stolen were jewellery, cash and a .22 air rifle with pellets



Next Meeting of the RH7 History Group





Community Invited to Help Paint Mindful Mural at Viewpoint Centre

A local charity supporting young people experiencing school anxiety and isolation is inviting the community to help create a collaborative mural designed to promote calm and wellbeing.

Viewpoint Centre CIO, based in Dormansland, runs **TheHorseCourse**, an equine-assisted intervention programme supporting children and young people – together with their families – who are in crisis, overwhelmed, shut down, or unable to attend school.

The programme is unique in that young people attend **alongside their parents**, and where possible **their school**, helping rebuild confidence, communication and connection together.

The centre also runs **weekly forest school experiences** for those with SEN challenges, as well as a community wellbeing group called **Men At Walk**, encouraging people to reconnect with nature, movement and each other.

The charity has now launched the **Mindful Mural Project**, working with local artist **Claire Heffron** to transform the lower walls of its indoor arena into a calming seascape. At the centre of the mural is a **striking whale surrounded by blank stars**, which participants will gradually fill in during painting sessions. Each person will paint a star, leaving their own mark on what will become a lasting piece of community artwork.

The idea for the project came following a chance conversation at a local Christmas fair organised by **Adele Norris of The Three Fish Clothing**, generous supporters of the charity. During the event, the charity's founder discussed ideas for enhancing the therapeutic

environment at Viewpoint Centre – and artist Claire Heffron quickly came on board to help bring the vision to life.

Community members **aged 16 and over** are invited to register their interest in small painting sessions taking place throughout March, April and beyond.



FIRE SAFETY IN THE HOME

Keeping you safe from fire, while you stay safe at home.

IN THE KITCHEN...

DON'T leave pans unattended while cooking and **NEVER** leave children and pets in the kitchen alone.

Keep cooking areas clear from combustible items like tea towels, oven gloves and food packaging.

Clean your oven and grill regularly. A build up of fat and grease can cause a fire.

Ditch the chip pan.

ELECTRICAL ITEMS

Check your electrical appliances are in good working order. If the wires are damaged or frayed, do not use them.

DON'T leave washing machines, tumble dryers or dishwashers running overnight.

HEATERS should be kept well away from clothes, curtains, furniture and other flammable materials.

NEVER use heaters to dry clothes. Make sure they're switched off and unplugged before you go to bed.



SMOKE ALARMS

save lives, but only if they're working. You should have **AT LEAST ONE** smoke alarm on every level of your home.

You should test your smoke alarms at least weekly.

ONE SOCKET = ONE PLUG



Don't overload your plug sockets. Appliances such as washing machines should have a single plug to themselves as they are high powered.



CANDLES must never be left unattended when lit and must be fully extinguished before you leave the room or go to bed.

Keep candles away from flammable items like curtains, furniture, bedding, clothing or books. Consider using LED battery operated candles instead.

ESCAPE ROUTES

Plan an escape route and make sure everyone in the home knows how to escape.

Keep exits clear from clutter and obstructions.

Keep your door and window keys in a known and accessible place.

Think of a second escape route in case the first one is blocked.

If you have an emergency pendant, make sure you wear it and have it close by at bedtime.



PUT IT OUT - RIGHT OUT



NEVER smoke in bed.

Take extra care if you smoke when tired, taking prescription drugs that make you feel drowsy or have been drinking.

Be sure to use a proper ashtray that can't tip over.

Be careful if you smoke and use emollient creams - they can soak into clothing, bedding and dressings leaving a flammable residue.

REMEMBER, IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE, GET OUT, STAY OUT, AND CALL 999.






